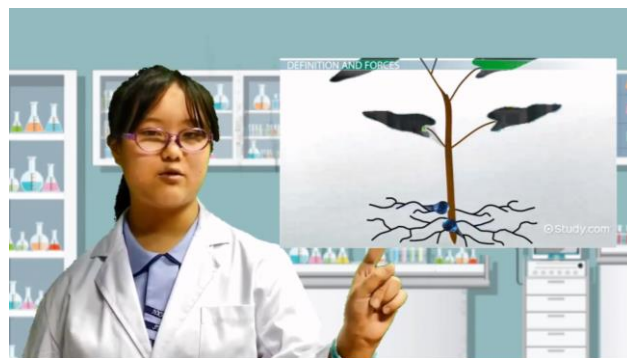
We can watch the episodes again on SYTV website or YouTube to enjoy them with our family and friends too! So great!
